The New Zealand School of Music operates from Massey University (Mt Cook, Albany and Palmerston North) and Victoria University (Kelburn) campuses. Composition and Musicology are based at Kelburn. Classical Performance is divided between Mt. Cook and Kelburn. Jazz Performance is based at Mt Cook and Albany. Music Therapy is based at Mt Cook. Some academic papers are available extramurally from Palmerston North.

This handbook contains a calendar of dates, staff contact details and other practical information relating to your study at the NZSM. You will also find information about central university services that can provide you with support when you need it.

Details of the content and requirements of your papers are given in the Paper Outlines which will be posted on Blackboard, a web-based facility for students and staff to which you will be introduced by your lecturers at the first class for each course you are taking.

Access Hours

The **Albany** building is open from 7am until 6pm, Monday to Friday. You have after-hours access to these buildings until midnight with a swipe card. Weekend hours are from 9am until midnight with a swipe card.

The **Kelburn** buildings are open from approximately 7am until approximately 6pm, Monday to Friday. After hours access is available at all other times with a swipe card. Your swipe card will automatically be activated once your fees are paid.

The **Mt Cook** building is open from 7am until 6pm, Monday to Friday. You have after-hours access from 6pm until midnight, Monday to Friday, and from 9am until midnight on Saturday and Sunday with a swipe card. Please ask at the NZSM office about swipe card details.

NB Post-grad students have 24 hour access.

Leave

If you need to be absent from the NZSM for professional or personal reasons, you must apply in writing to the Programme Leader of your discipline (see staff-list below). Leave may be granted under the following conditions:

- Leave of absence will be granted only at the discretion of the Director of the NZSM.
- Unless there are special circumstances all applications must be lodged in writing with your Programme Leader not less than three weeks before the period of absence requested. Leave forms are available for this purpose at the NZSM offices. Leave for professional reasons must be for clearly programme-related activities.
- Leave for professional reasons should not be for more than two weeks, and must take place at a time which does not conflict with assessment and evaluation periods.
- Leave for professional reasons must have ongoing professional scrutiny.
- It is your responsibility, in advance, to consult the co-ordinators of each paper you are enrolled in, to check the due dates of assignments. It will be your responsibility to make up the material covered in classes during your leave period. If you are taking papers with weekly assessment, e.g. music theory papers, leave will be granted only in exceptional circumstances.
- You may be required to forfeit any student allowance for which you are eligible during the period of absence from the NZSM.

Change of contact details

It is highly likely that while studying at the NZSM you will probably change your contact details at least once! If your circumstances change, please keep your contact details on MyVictoria <http://my.vuw.ac.nz> updated at all times, otherwise staff may not be able to contact you with important information. Please also inform the NZSM office of any changes.

Security

The NZSM is not responsible if you lose any of your personal effects, or for any theft that takes place while belongings are left unattended. Doors must not under any circumstance be propped open after hours - this endangers other students' safety and poses a security risk to NZSM facilities.

Smoking on University Campuses

Victoria University of Wellington and Massey University operate non-smoking policies on all of their campuses.

In general, Victoria University does not permit smoking under cover ways, atriums, or within three metres of any building. The open courtyard on the second level of the School of Music premises at Kelburn is considered to be part of the building and is consequently a non-smoking area.

Massey University, Mt Cook site is a non-smoking area except for designated areas where students may smoke. Smoking in the vicinity of the main entrance to Block One or near the Concert Hall entrance is prohibited.

Student Services

As an NZSM student you have access to the student services of both Massey and Victoria Universities. Generally you will only need to show your NZSM ID card, though sometimes you may need to take additional action to access particular services. If there are any problems contact an NZSM office. If you wish to use counselling or health services you will need to register at the University of your home campus.

Student ID cards

All NZSM students need to collect their student ID cards from the Enrolments Office at Victoria University, located on level 0 of the Victoria University Library in Kelburn. You can email a photo to enrolment-enquiries@vuw.ac.nz with your student ID beforehand, or have a photo taken when you go to collect your card. You must be fully enrolled and have paid your fees in full to receive your student ID card.

Library Services

As an NZSM student, you will have access to the libraries on the Albany, Kelburn and Mt Cook campuses. You will need your NZSM ID card to use and borrow from these libraries.

IT access

Mt Cook:

Mt Cook based students need to fill out a Massey University IT user request form available from the NZSM office. Access can take a while to process so it is recommended that if possible, students fill these out prior to semester starting. Kelburn students who have classes at Mt Cook may also request Massey IT access.

Kelburn:

ITS computers on all campuses offer access to myVictoria – the student portal – and also to standard software such as Microsoft Office, and other specialised software like SPSS and Endnote. Charges for printing are on a cost-recovery basis. There is no charge for internet usage. If you are having trouble logging on to myVictoria or this is the first time you are using your ITS account, you will need to reset your student password. This is explained in Victoria's student guide.

Computer rooms

Mt Cook:

The computer room at Mt Cook is in room 1D02, accessible by swipe card. The room is not available for student use when there are classes being held in it. Other computers are available in the library and computer rooms on the Massey University campus.

Kelburn:

The keyboard laboratory room 112 is accessible to all students, via swipe card, when classes are not being held in there. Other computers are available around Victoria University campus and in the library.

Photocopying

Please note the NZSM adheres to strict copyright law. Do not copy more than 5% of any book or copyright material.

There is no photocopying available for undergraduate students at the NZSM.

Student photocopying is available in the Massey and Kelburn libraries.

Lockers

Mt Cook:

At Mt Cook there are 20 lockers available for student use on a first come first served basis. There is no cost for these, but students must provide their own padlocks. It is optional if you would like to keep a spare key with the office. Lockers are re-allocated each year at the start of trimester – sign up sheets will be posted in the office in the first week of term.

Kelburn:

At Kelburn there are a variety of lockers available. These are allocated by the NZSM Office. Please come to the NZSM office to request a locker. Those lockers that have a key provided by the NZSM will require a \$15 key bond. Students will be asked to empty their lockers at the end of the 2nd trimester. Locks will be cut and lockers will be emptied after Monday 15 November. Students will have to make a special request to retain their locker over the summer period.

Instrument storerooms

Mt Cook:

The Mt Cook campus has two instrument storerooms – located in the middle corridor of the practice rooms – rooms 1C21 and 31. These are kept locked at all times. To obtain a key, students must go to the Contact Centre in block 4 at Massey, pay \$10 and bring the receipt to the NZSM office where they will be issued a key. Alternatively there is a key in the office that can be borrowed and brought back each time.

Use of facilities and practice rooms

Mt Cook:

Practice rooms and combo rehearsal rooms are able to be booked at 2 hours maximum per booking. Booking sheets are posted on Monday mornings on the noticeboards opposite the combo rooms. You must be in a practice room during your booking to retain your right to use it. Strictly no non-NZSM students may be brought into the building for rehearsals without prior permission from the NZSM.

Kelburn:

Level 1 practice room booking sheets are available on the notice board next to Room 102. The booking sheets are posted on the previous Thursday for the following week. Only performance students can book a practice room, but other music students may use the rooms if they are vacant. There are strict room booking rules which are printed alongside these sheets. The following rooms are booked through the booking system on the counter of the Kelburn NZSM Office, Room 101, 211, 209, ACR, (and EMS studios - relevant for sonic arts students only). All these rooms follow the room booking rules outlined on the counter.

Student common room / kitchens

Mt Cook:

There is a student kitchen 'DIY kai' located in the Student Centre on level 1.

Kelburn:

There is a student common room and kitchen located in the courtyard of the Kelburn NZSM building.

Students with Disabilities

If you have a disability you will need to register at the University of your home campus to use its Disability Support Services.

Student Health Clinic

Student health services are available to all currently enrolled NZSM students and any dependants. This service provides a high standard of primary care, with experienced General Practitioners and registered nurses. Transport and Parking

Each campus has designated student parking areas. At the Albany campus all student parking is free. There are pay and display parking areas at Kelburn Campus as well as student parking areas. Student parking require a parking permit and applications for permits are available from VUWSA. To park in a pay and display area at the Mt Cook campus you will need a permit. These can be bought from the Pyramid Coffee Cart beside the Massey Contact Centre. It is also possible to purchase a parking permit for the entire trimester and applications for these are also obtained from the Pyramid Coffee Cart.

If you are travelling from Mt Cook to Kelburn there is a 'Campus Connection' bus route which runs from Wallace St (outside Mt Cook campus) up to Kelburn Parade. Buses run twice hourly throughout the day and more frequently at peak times. For more information visit www.metlink.org.nz. Key Dates

In Wellington both NZSM campuses follow Victoria University's trimester dates, so if you are studying at Mt Cook your breaks will be at different times from other Massey students. Albany and extramural students follow the Massey timetable. All NZSM exams will be scheduled in the exam period common to both universities.
